What is DriveImage XML?

It is a program you can use to image and backup your computer's hard drives.

What can you do with DriveImage XML?

1. Backup your hard drive and/or partitions to image files
2. Browse these images, view and extract files
3. Restore these images to same or different drive
4. Copy directly from drive to drive
5. Schedule backups using windows Task Scheduler

What Operating systems are supported by DriveImage XML?

1. Windows XP
2. Windows Server 2003
3. Windows Vista

What type of drive formats does it support?

1. FAT 12
2. FAT 16
3. FAT 32
4. NTFS

What is the cost of DriveImage XML?

1. Free

Can you write the data directly to CD/DVD?

1. No, currently you can only restore your data to a partition that is exactly the same size or larger, regardless of the data size.
